Cooperation between Kiel University and Universität Hamburg

On the basis of the cooperation agreement, students have the right to

extend their specialist study focus

by attending lectures and taking examinations at the other university if this is agreed by the corresponding examiner at Universität Hamburg.

This provision is to be interpreted as follows: the right to attend lectures and take examinations does not apply to compulsory courses of Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes.

Likewise, the cooperation agreement does not entitle students to attend lectures at Universität Hamburg and take the associated examinations if these are also offered in similar form at Kiel University.

Students are also not entitled to take complete courses in optional subjects or specialist courses at Universität Hamburg. Academic achievements or certificates from corresponding lectures are not recognised.
